



SOME POINTERS ON HOW TO FILL IN THE ONLINE PROPOSAL

Proposed Research in Pairs 1 + Optional Research in Pairs 2

- Duration: lasting 1, 2 and up to 3 weeks (or between 7 and 21 days in total)
- Participants: gathering from 2 to 4 participants. Including at least either the Chair holder or Local Project holder. Of course, both can also decide to work together, with one or two other people.
- Rationale: The idea is to work on a project (such as putting the final touches to an article, discussing a paper, writing chapters of a book etc.).
- Dates: 3 sets of dates should be proposed. It is of course easier for CIRM to accommodate these smaller-sized events, although dates should still be provided early to ensure that studio accommodation is indeed available, in case several Research in Pairs run during the same period.
- Funding: CIRM provides full subsidy for residential costs (accommodation in studios and meals at the restaurant Monday to Friday) but only for non-local guests. The chairholder and local project leader pay for their own meals at the reduced rate. If a participant is a local mathematician, meals can be charged to the "Programme of Invitations" at the normal rate (around €15 a meal). At week-ends meals can be cooked by the residential participants in their studios, as these are equipped with kitchenettes.
- Up to two Research in pairs event can be covered by CIRM funding.
- Extra Research in pairs meetings can of course be organized and are then covered by the "Programme of invitations".
- You may choose to refund travel out of the "Programme of invitations" grant.
- The "Programme of Invitations" should not be used as appropriate funding for restaurants and/or other outings since meals can be offered onsite during the week and facilities are provided in studios for week-end cooking.
- Online description: Please describe the various Research in pairs meetings you intend to organize in sufficient details for the rapporteurs to get relevant information about the work intended. It is also useful for the scientific committee to have access to the CVs of the chosen guests.
